2022 COPIC Humanitarian Award: Kevin Reichmuth

We are proud to announce that Dr. Kevin Reichmuth a pulmonologist from Lincoln, was chosen as the recipient of the 2022 Nebraska COPIC Humanitarian Award. Dr. Reichmuth is recognized for his commitment to making a difference in health care. The award was presented to Dr. Reichmuth at the Annual Nebraska Medical Association Meeting on August 19th.

Dr. Kevin Reichmuth is a native of Columbus, NE and is passionate about health care advocacy and education. During the COVID-19 pandemic, Dr. Reichmuth provided bedside clinic care to hundreds of patients impacted by the virus and volunteered as a medical expert to the local health department as well as the State Department of Public Health. He provided community status updates to local physicians during weekly educational meetings and always volunteered to be interviewed by the media regarding the pandemic and provided excellent health care advice.

In addition to his COVID efforts, Dr. Reichmuth and his partners were one of the first Lincoln area clinics to volunteer to participate in the Lancaster County Medical Foundation's Medical Assistance program, which provides access to health care for approximately 1,500 uninsured individuals each year.
